

PERMISSION SLIP & CODE OF CONDUCT

SKI TRIP 2006, Troop 911, January 7-8, 2006

All Scouts planning to go on the Ski Trip must complete and turn in this form.

Code of Conduct for Motel and Skiing

Noise levels will be kept at a minimum

No congregating in the rooms

No food or drink in rooms

No running in halls or elsewhere

No horseplay at any time

No swimming at the motel

Do not go outside the motel building without adult supervision

Lights out and no talking after 10pm

Curfew from 10pm until 6am – stay in the room

Safety rules must be observed in the motel

Skiers' responsibility code to be observed

Adult leaders will invoke and communicate other rules as appropriate and necessary

Disciplinary Procedure

If the code is broken the following steps will be taken:

1st offense: Verbal Warning

2nd offense: Assigned full time to an adult leader for close supervision

3rd offense: Parent will be called and asked to come pickup the Scout

For severe offenses, the Scoutmaster reserves the right to skip straight to step three.
