## **Packing**

Pack overnight clothing and ski clothing in one bag

Recommended ski wear: Bibs or ski pants, warm jacket, long underwear, non-ribbed medium or heavyweight socks, ski gloves, tight knit hat, lip balm and sunscreen. Layered clothing is a desirable, sock liners and glove liners are helpful, goggles and/or sun glasses are helpful; scarf or face mask for very cold, windy days; ski wear can be rented at local ski supply stores.

Have warm, dry clothing accessible to change into for the ride home (especially socks).

## **Travel on January 6**

Meet at Burkhead on Saturday afternoon at 1:45pm.

TAKE CARE OF WEEKEND HOMEWORK BEFORE LEAVING.

Drive to Princeton, WV where we will spend the night.

Personal vehicles will be used for transportation.

Scouts should bring additional money for weekend meals/snacks (\$25-30 recommended.)

## **Arrival at the Motel**

Room assignments will be made by adult leaders ahead of time

Beginners must take a one-hour lesson; ski lessons are available for all, assigned by skill level

Merit Badge lessons will be available for Snow Sports Merit Badge

- not recommended for a beginner; requires some proficiency

Scouts buy their own lunch and snacks at the slopes

Lockers are available for rent at the ski slopes (requires 4 quarters to open)

## End of the Day

Skiing ends around 4:00 PM

Return ski equipment and proceed to meeting spot (to be determined)

Ride home in assigned vehicle

We will stop for supper on the way home (burger place)

Arrive back at Burkhead on Sunday evening about 7:00pm.
