All Scouts planning to go on the Ski Trip must complete and turn in this form.

Code of Conduct for Motel and Skiing

- Noise levels will be kept at a minimum
- No congregating in the rooms
- No food or drink in rooms
- No running in halls or elsewhere
- No horseplay at any time
- No swimming at the motel
- Do not go outside the motel building without adult supervision
- Lights out and no talking after 10pm
- Curfew from 10pm until 6am – stay in the room
- Safety rules must be observed in the motel
- Skiers' responsibility code to be observed
- Adult leaders will invoke and communicate other rules as appropriate and necessary

Disciplinary Procedure

If the code is broken the following steps will be taken:

- 1st offense: Verbal Warning
- 2nd offense: Assigned full time to an adult leader for close supervision
- 3rd offense: Parent will be called and asked to come pickup the Scout

For severe offenses, the Scoutmaster reserves the right to skip straight to step three.
