

# CHERRY POINT MARINE CORPS AIR SHOW

**MAY 21 – 23, 2010 (Friday – Sunday)**

Boy Scout Troop 911 will be attending the MCAS Cherry Point Air Show the weekend of May 21, 22, and 23, 2010. The MCAS is located in Havelock, NC and is on the Neuse River. This trip will be a **2-overnight camping** trip and the boys will also be able to get approximately **8 hours of community service**. We have been working with the public affairs unit at the air base, and our troop will be camping on air base property at one of their designated camp sites. We will be allowed to eat breakfast and dinner meals on both Saturday and Sunday in the dining facility (mess hall) right on the air base. The boys and the leaders will be “working” at the air show about three to four hours each day and these hours will qualify for service hours toward the Boy Scout rank requirements. Our “work” will be coordinated with the air base personnel, and we will probably be delivering water to the vendors, or collecting recyclable items. Also, this activity will fulfill some of the requirements for the **aviation merit badge** for those boys who might be interested.

This is a great opportunity for all of the boys who might be able to attend. I would suggest looking up more information about the air show at [www.cherrypointairshow.com](http://www.cherrypointairshow.com). In addition to the routine permission sheet from the Boy Scouts, the MCAS department of legal affairs will also require a signed permission sheet for all attendees (boys and adults). You will find this “Release from Liability/Hold Harmless Agreement” as an attachment on Troop 911 web site. We will also need a copy of the driver’s license and car registration for each adult leader who will be attending the trip. This is a requirement so we can take our vehicles on air base property, beyond designated air show parking. If you have questions and/or if any parents are interested in going on this trip please check with the scout leaders.

**Cost:** \$20 per scout, which will cover to/from transportation, camping and meals on base. The boys will need to bring extra money for spending and for dinners on the way down and back.

**Deadline:** We need to have all forms signed and returned by **March 23<sup>rd</sup>**, so we can get the information to the MCAS by April 1<sup>st</sup>.
