Gear: All Scouts should bring clothes that can get wet (you will get wet) and closed toe shoes are required on the river. Camping gear should always include Rain gear, Change of clothes, Personal mess kit, Sleeping bag and pad.

1. Head south on Silas Creek Pkwy SW About 2 mins	go 1.7 mi total 1.7 mi
2. Take I-40 W toward Statesville About 2 hours 28 mins	go 161 mi total 162 mi
3. Slight right at US-74 W (signs for US-19/US-23/US-74/Clyde/Waynesville) About 55 mins	go 53.2 mi total 216 mi

Total time: 3.5 hours Total distance: 216 miles
