

Transportation Policies Troop 911, BSA March 2007

- 1. Transportation to Troup Outings:** The Troop will follow National BSA policies regarding transportation to and from Troop outings at remote locations such as monthly camping trips or other monthly outings or summer camp at Raven Knob. These policies are set forth in the BSA Guide to Safe Scouting and other BSA Publications.

- 2. Transportation to Weekly Meetings and General Local Events:** It is the responsibility of the parents or guardians of the Scout to supervise transportation to and from weekly meetings and other general local Troop events such as volunteer activities and training meetings. The parents or guardians are expected to instruct the Scout as to permitted transportation and drivers to and from weekly meetings and general local events and each Scout is expected to obtain parental or guardian permission prior to riding with any driver other than a parent or guardian. The Troop leaders are not expected to supervise transportation of the Scouts to and from weekly meetings or general local Troop events. Although the Troop leaders will not be supervising such transportation, if an adult Troop leader asks a Scout about permitted transportation and is not satisfied with the response, then the Scout must follow the decision of the adult leader without further discussion or argument. Any failure of the Scout or parents or guardians to follow the transportation policies will result in discipline of the Scout in accordance with Troop policies.
